Questions and Answers

- Q1. I would like to clarify regarding the eligibility for this submission. Can a private Israeli company apply for this grant or it can only be listed as a party or supplier of services?
- A1. Yes. Section IV “Additional Considerations” of the BAA explains that “Public, private, for-profit, and nonprofit organizations, as well as institutions of higher education, public international organizations, non-governmental organizations, U.S. and non-U.S. governmental organizations, multilateral and international donor organizations, and individuals (in the expert category of interested parties only) are eligible under this BAA. All organizations must be determined to be responsive to the BAA and sufficiently responsible to perform or participate in the final award type.”
- Q2. Would an Estonian firm be eligible to submit an EOI under this BAA?
- A2. Yes. Please see the answer to the question Q1.
