Program Overview

The [Transforming Pediatrics for Early Childhood \(TPEC\) Program](#) increases **statewide** access to high-quality early childhood development services for young children and their families, delivered through **team-based care** in **pediatric primary care settings**.

Recipients improve the quality and cost-effectiveness of pediatric care by delivering a comprehensive, team-based approach that focuses on factors critical to child development. The program prioritizes services for young children and their families who are eligible for Medicaid or the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) or are uninsured.

Place early childhood development (ECD) experts in pediatric practices who deliver early childhood services as part of a team.



Build the skills of pediatric primary care staff statewide to early childhood services as a team.



Expand and sustain early childhood services delivered by a team to improve the standard of care for all young children.
