The Cost Proposal must include a summary budget for the proposed project overall, along with lineitem budgets for the applicant and each proposed subrecipient. The applicant's Cost Proposal will be evaluated based on how well it supports the overall project strategy, as well as how reasonable and proportionate it is to the expected outcomes and impact.
