127) Q. As a small organization, we have never received a formal audit. Can we propose copies of our financial statements and a signed certification from our accountant that they are accurate instead?

A. All eligible Applicants must submit their most recent single audit as part of a complete application package. An application that does not include all documentation required by this notice of funding opportunity at the time of application will be deemed ineligible. Applicants should review page 13 and 29 of the NOFO regarding the single audit requirement.

128) Q. The NOFO references a GS-15, Step 10 compensation cap of \$162,672 annually, aligned with the OPM salary table. However, the corresponding daily and hourly rates, \$623.60/day and \$77.95/hour, do not reflect standard federal calculations (which would be \$625.66/day and \$78.21/hour, respectively). Could USDA clarify whether it intends to update these rates, or if a different formula or basis was used?

129) Q. Is this grant program a requirement to bid on commodity solicitations?

AMS issues solicitations on an ongoing basis for over 200 different USDA Foods. Approved USDA Vendors are invited to submit offers via the Web-Based Supply Chain Management System (WBSCM).
