- **Who is eligible to participate?**

In accordance with 54 U.S.C. § 101702(d) Cooperative Agreements for System Unit Natural Resource Protection this funding opportunity is limited to State, local, or tribal governments, other Federal agencies, other public entities, educational institutions, and private nonprofit organizations.

In addition, an expanded version of eligible applicants is listed on the grant.gov NOFO listing, which contains the approved eligible applicants for Assistance Listing 15.944 Natural Resource Stewardship:

- **Can multiple partners work together on this agreement?**

If an organization chooses to apply for this opportunity, then they would need to be the singular applicant. We are not able to have a cooperative agreement that includes multiple recipients. However, as the potential "Prime Recipient," you are welcome to contract out or subaward some of the work. This would be the mechanism to bring other entities into the agreement. I'd recommend that you explicitly describe in the application if you would plan to do this, with whom you'd plan to work, and the specific skills/experience that they have to help this project succeed.
