USAID/ Haiti intends to issue a Grant – to a qualified applicant is to support the Haitian Ministry of Education (*Ministere de l'Education Nationale et de la Formation Professionnelle - MENFP*) to increase safe and equitable access to quality education for out-of-school children and youth aged 12-18 through the provision of an accelerated learning program (ALP).
