ACTION: Amendment to ETA-UIPL-22-21-CH2 (Notice of Cancellation)

SUMMARY: The U.S. Department of Labor, Employment and Training Administration, announces the cancellation of ETA-UIPL-22-21-CH2, the Additional ARPA Funding and Support for States to Strengthen UI Program Integrity, including ID Verification, Fraud Prevention and Detection, and Overpayment Recovery Efforts in All UC Programs, posted to Grants.gov on April 28, 2023.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: On June 3, 2023, the President signed Public Law 118-5, Fiscal Responsibility Act of 2023, to increase the federal debt limit, establish new discretionary spending limits, rescind unobligated funds, and expand work requirements for federal programs. Among the rescinded unobligated funds, the Fiscal Responsibility Act contained a rescission of funding that was to be used for this funding opportunity. In light of the rescission, ETA must cancel this funding opportunity. We will not review applications submitted through Grants.gov or any other submission method in response to this funding opportunity. All applications that were submitted will be properly disposed in accordance with applicable Federal record-keeping requirements.
