Dear Prospective Applicants:

The purposes of this amendment are to (1) correct USAID's answer to Question no. 15 of Amendment 1 of this NOFO and (2) address the follow up clarification question to the answer in Question no. 15.

Question no. 15: NOFO page 35 "D. Risk Assessment." What is the submission time of the documents required under this section?

USAID: Submission of section "D. Risk Assessment" documentation will be requested after the completion of Phase 2 -Oral Presentation, from the Apparently Successful Applicant (ASA) **once** determined by the Agreement Officer (page 32 of the NOFO).

Clarification Question: Please clarify whether a summary budget is required to be submitted as part of Phase 1. And if so, do applicants also need to submit associated supporting documents including Certifications, Assurances and Other Statements and others as defined under the NOFO Section D page 35 for Phase 1?

USAID: A summary budget and associated supporting documents are not required in Phase 1 – Concept Paper submission. Certifications, Assurances and Other Statements as defined under Section D of the NOFO (page 35) are also not required in Phase 1 – Concept Paper.

This amendment does not obligate USAID to execute an award, nor does it commit USAID to pay any costs incurred in the preparation and submission of applications. Furthermore, the U.S. Government reserves the right to reject any and all applications, if such action is considered to be in the best interest of the U.S. government. All other terms and conditions of this funding opportunity remain the same.
