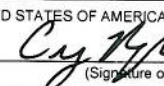

A. Specific changes to the RFA as stated below:

1. On the cover letter of the RFA delete the first paragraph and replace with the following:

“The United States Agency for International Development (USAID), is seeking applications (proposals for funding) from U.S. or non-U.S. non-governmental organizations (NGOs), Public International Organizations (PIOs), and/or consortia to implement the Counter Trafficking in Persons Program (CTIP II) which will build on the notable successes of CTIP while broadening the focus to more inclusively address the needs of victims of forced labor. The incumbent for this program is The Asia Foundation (TAF) and TAF is eligible to submit an application for CTIP II. USAID/Cambodia is issuing a request for applications for a cooperative agreement for CTIP II. Please refer to the Program Description (RFA section C) for a complete statement of goals and expected results.”

2. On page 23 of the RFA, Section C.2 second paragraph third line, delete “...the writing of this AAD” and replace with “...the writing of this RFA.”
3. On page 28 of the RFA, Section C.4.1, Annual Work Plans, delete “.....Fiscal Year 2011” and replace with “....Fiscal Year 2012”

B. Questions and Responses:

Question 1: Are Public International Organizations (PIOs) eligible to submit an application under this RFA?

USAID Response 1: Yes.

Question 2: Are “for-profit” companies eligible to submit an application under this RFA?

USAID Response 2: For the purposes of this solicitation, NGOs include any incorporated entity, either non-profit or for-profit, other than a governmental organization. Applicants may form partnerships with other academic institutions, private sector entities, or NGOs in submitting applications.
