The purpose of this Amendment No. 4 to APS No. Indonesia 09-014 “Supporting Universities to Partner Across the Pacific” is to clarify and revise the language in No. 12 of the Q&A for APS Amendment No. 3 with regard to the eligibility of applicants under this APS.

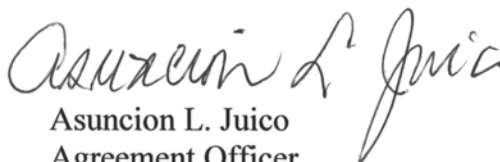
Accordingly, Amendment No. 3, Q&A No. 12 is hereby amended as follows:

Concept papers may be submitted by institutions of higher education in the United States or in Indonesia. As described in Section I.E.2 of APS Amendment No. 2 dated February 3, 2010, partnerships must include at least one institution of higher education in each country. Applicants should take actions and submit materials that demonstrate the level of collaboration required to implement an effective program and score well per the criteria used to evaluate the concept papers. As described in Section II.B.b of APS Amendment No. 2 describing the application requirements for Technical narrative, the concept paper must demonstrate “how partners have worked together in formulating the proposed activities and how the proposed partnership will benefit all members.” Furthermore, a profile of the partners is required to clarify the “division of responsibilities in the proposed partnership.” How to demonstrate the arrangements for partnerships is up to the applicant.

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Issuance of this Amendment No. 4 to APS No. Indonesia 09-014 does not constitute a commitment on the part of the U.S. Government to make an award nor does it commit the Government to pay for costs incurred in the preparation and submission of a concept paper or application. Further, the U.S. Government reserves the right to reject any or all concept papers or applications received. In addition, final award of any resultant Agreement cannot be made until funds have been fully appropriated, allocated, and committed through internal USAID procedures the condition on which this APS is issued. All terms and conditions of the APS-Indonesia-09-014 issued on August 10, 2009, as amended per Amendment No. 2 dated February 3, 2010, remains unchanged and in full force and effect.
