Question 1:

On page two of the NOFO, it states that "The U.S. Dollar amount will be funded from INL allocated funds, for an initial project period of up to 3 years." But then on page page it states more clearly that "The period of performance is three (3) years with an anticipated start date of March 2019." With the current award ceiling at only \$850,000, please verify the actual period of performance and budget. Is it \$850,000 for three years and/or could it be \$850,000 for a period less than three years as indicated on page two of the NOFO?

Answer:

INL is open to considering a proposal that addresses all elements of the NOFO for \$850,000 for a period less than three years as indicated on page two of the NOFO. For instance, INL would be amenable to reviewing a proposal for an initial 18 months of programming.

Pending availability of funding and State Department management approval, INL may later consider amendments to allow implementation of engagement activities proposed by the successful applicant for a cumulative period of performance of up to five years.
