1. Under **Section A.2** Estimate of Funds Available and Number of Awards Contemplated,
 - a. **DELETE** the paragraph and **REPLACE** with the following.

“USAID intends to award one Cooperative Agreement pursuant to this notice of funding opportunity. Subject to funding availability and at the discretion of the Agency, USAID intends to provide up to \$16,200,000.00 in total USAID funding over a five-year period, which includes an Unfunded Budget Allocation or “Opportunity Node” of \$2.7 million inclusive of indirect costs.

This unfunded budget allocation of \$2.7 million is not guaranteed. The opportunity node is intended to facilitate the prompt expansion of programming should circumstances warrant. Circumstances warranting the expansion of activities include expanding the geographic focus of implementation, intensifying an element(s) of the activity or responding to unforeseen risks or crises within the broad activity objectives described herein. The Opportunity Node will be activated through a bilateral modification to this award and will only be made available at the sole discretion of USAID.

All funding will be provided on an incremental basis, subject to the availability of funds and successful performance. USAID reserves the right to change the funding amounts, cycle, and terms of the agreement as a result of availability of funding, U.S. Government requirements, or Recipient performance.”

2. Under **Section C.VII** Substantial Involvement,

- a. **DELETE** the first bullet and **REPLACE** with the following.

“Approval of recipient’s Annual Implementation Plans. Additionally, if the opportunity node is activated, revisions to the approved implementation plan will be submitted for AOR approval within 30 days of award modification issuance.”

- b. **DELETE** the fifth bullet and **REPLACE** with the following.

“Approval of Activity Monitoring, Evaluation and Learning (MEL) Plans. If the opportunity node is activated by the AO, revisions to the MEL Plans, as relevant, will be submitted for AOR approval within 30 days of award modification issuance.”
