The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) issues Program Announcement No. OSBDC-2016-04 to invite applications from institutions of higher education (including but not limited to any land-grant college or university, any college or school of business, engineering, commerce, or agriculture, community college or junior college) or a Women's Business Center currently funded by SBA and operating under § 29 of the Small Business Act located in the state of Utah only as authorized by Section 21(a) of the Small Business Act, (15 USC Section 648);

The SBDC national network program is the SBA's largest matching grant, funding a service delivery network to provide high quality business and economic development assistance to small businesses and nascent entrepreneurs in order to promote growth, expansion, innovation, increased productivity and management improvement. These SBDCs, in partnership with SBA's Office of Small Business Development Centers (OSBDC) and their local SBA District Office, develop programs and provide business management and other services that enhance the economic development goals and objectives of SBA and their other respective state and local funding partners located within the state of Utah. The SBDC program is a broad-based system of assistance for the small business community that links the resources of Federal, state, and local governments with those of the educational community and the private sector. Although SBA is responsible for the general management and oversight of the SBDC program, a partnership exists between SBA and the recipient organization to effectuate the delivery of assistance to the small business community.
