ADDITIONAL QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

SECTION A: PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

1. Q&A #40 requires applicants to include Performance Indicator Reference Sheets (PIRSs) for each proposed performance indicator as part of the Annex 2: AMELP in the application. Because each PIRS is 2-3 pages long, this will add several dozen pages to the application. We respectfully request that USAID reserve the PIRS requirement for the draft and final AMELP submitted post award. For the application, would USAID allow applicants to include a list of proposed indicators and annual and life of project targets for performance indicators in the Annex 2: AMELP?

USAID Response: USAID requires all applicants to submit a complete AMELP with their Application that conforms with Section A.12. To shorten the AMELP, applicants only need to include the PIRS for custom indicators (as opposed to USAID standard indicators). All other components of the AMELP (as described in Section A.12) should be included.
