

Addendum B: Vetting Questions for Applicants who are not current INL partners

If your agency has not previously answered this questionnaire, please submit answers to the following questions, with supporting documentation, as part of your application. Applicants who have not previously answered this questionnaire and who do not submit answers as part of this application will not be considered.

1. Does your agency perform standard correctional operations such as: administration, including budget and finance, human resources, planning, records, training, correctional center operations, prison industries, prisoner programs, medical services, food services, other support services, maintenance, prisoner transportation, probation, etc.? Please provide a comprehensive list of all areas of institutional, field, and administrative operational areas.
2. Do you operate a certified training academy, which trains all staff? Please provide a detailed description of the academy, its facilities, curricula, and the name and authority of the certifying agency.
3. Is your agency currently under a court master? If so, please provide details.
4. Are any members of the senior leadership (warden or above) currently under criminal indictment or investigation for actions taken as a department official? Please explain.
5. Within the past ten (10) years how many investigations for civil rights violations have been conducted and what was the outcome of those investigations?
6. Within the past five (5) years have any senior officials been found guilty of criminal conduct in their official capacity? If so, provide details.
7. Is your agency currently certified by an independent agency or association? If so, what is the name of the certifying body. If it was certified at one time but is not currently, what is the reason for current non-certification?
8. Is your agency recognized nationally for a particular specialty area? If so, provide details.
9. Has your agency successfully participated in any international corrections assistance activities such as training or mentoring of foreign corrections personnel?
