The purpose of this APS amendment is to revise the submission format in the subject APS. The Office of Food for Peace has put in place a new Management Information System to support FFP application submissions, reporting, and program and financial management. This amendment updates the APS to align with changes to the electronic submission process.

Accordingly, the previously amended referenced APS, available at

is hereby further amended as follows:

- As of January 1, 2013, all partners are required to submit concept papers and applications for both Title II and EFSP submissions under this APS through the new Food for Peace Management Information System (FFPMIS) in addition to submitting to ffpemergency@macf.com.

Various information and documents cited in the subject APS will now be automated in FFPMIS. However, it is the responsibility of the partner to ensure that all required information is completed in FFPMIS whether it is manually entered or uploaded.
