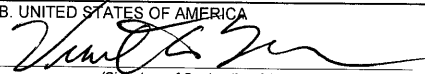

1. **Reference Section XIV Application Procedures** – The date of application submission has been changed from 1:00 PM on Monday, June 9, 2014 to 4:00 PM on Wednesday, June 25, 2014. The date of submission for questions has changed from 5:00 PM on Friday May 16, 2014 to 4:00 PM on Wednesday May 21, 2014.

2. **Reference Section XIII Eligibility Requirements** - The eligibility requirements has changed from:

“The successful State(s) must demonstrate that they have the infrastructure in place, as well as the necessary staff and support to carry out the responsibilities in developing, administering/coordinating and implementing this agreement. Only organizations capable of fulfilling the criteria listed below will be considered. Since this seat belt signage project requires the ability to cite people for the sole reason of not being restrained, eligible States must have a primary seat belt use law. This project will require placement of signage with a seat belt enforcement and/or fine based message supported by NHTSA’s Click It or Ticket (CIOT) high visibility enforcement model. States falling under primary seat belt jurisdiction shall be capable of installing the required signage and willing to write seat belt citations as a primary offense. To be an acceptable application, the Grantee must have the willingness and capacity to participate in a large-scale demonstration project and contribute adequate funding, staffing and support to carry out the functions related to the project over 30 months. The entity must also have extensive experience conducting high visibility enforcement to expedite the planning and implementation process. State Highway Safety Offices (SHSO’s), with primary seat belt laws, are uniquely positioned to perform this project as they have established highway safety programs, adequate staffing levels and specific and relevant staff experience, available funding , and many years of experience coordinating and implementing successful CIOT campaigns that utilize the high visibility enforcement model”.

“The successful Grantee must demonstrate that they have the infrastructure in place, as well as the necessary staff and support to carry out the responsibilities in developing, administering/coordinating and implementing this agreement. Eligible applicants will include not-for-profit organizations academic institutions, state offices of EMS and Public Safety”.
