Q&A (March 3, 2023):

- **Question 1:** One of the focuses of this grant, as per the NOFO, is the “rehabilitative care of victims returning to Maldives”, and identifies an objective as enhanced “victim care for returned FTF family members, especially regarding child victims.” How does the Bureau of Counterterrorism define the meaning of “victims” in this context, and to whom is it applied?
- **Response:** The purpose of this program is to support the rehabilitation and reintegration efforts of the Government of Maldives. With that in mind, a victim would be defined as it is under Section 60-15(a) of the Maldives Anti-Terrorism Act: a returnee who has undergone a risk assessment and determined not to have committed, or been an accessory to, or been trained to carry out an act of terrorism.
