1	9/16/2026	<u>Question #1</u> What committee-member travel volume should applicants assume for the two annual TRMTC meetings and related training or site visits?	About 20 TRMTC members travel to the U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) National Transportation Stakeholders Forum (NTSF) Annual Meeting, which typically has a TRMTC annual committee meeting scheduled in conjunction. There is also a mid-year meeting of TRMTC, also with about 20 TRMTC members attending. Approximately 4 TRMTC members travel to each DOE semi-annual Transportation Core Group meeting, 1-2 TRMTC members travel to each of the 4 State Regional Group (SRG) meetings in the fall (Northeast, South, Midwest, and West), and perhaps 1 or 2 TRMTC members travel to maybe one or two more relevant technical conferences or trainings. DOE is not anticipating any bugbear facility site visits as of now for FY27, however, there will be some outreach and training events occurring around DOE's high burnup reading cask shipment, that some TRMTC members may want to attend, and may or may not require travel.
