The City of Colton HCP was initiated in 2007 and is nearing completion. Approximately \$93,000 has already been expended by the City and additional funds have been awarded through a section 6 grant to support the planning efforts. The funds identified in this agreement will be used to complete the HCP, develop a funding strategy/ordinance and Nexus Study, prepare an Implementing Agreement, and develop the National Environmental Policy Act document. The City of Colton is developing at a rapid pace, and it is crucial to finish this HCP in order to streamline the permitting process as the City develops economically. The pressures on the City to balance healthy development and to maintain the area's unique environment have been enormous. In addition to streamlining the permitting process, the conserved areas will provide opportunities for public education about the endangered Delhi Sands Flower Loving Fly, associated species, and the larger Colton Dunes ecosystem.
