Question # 1.) If an applicant were to apply as the prime grantee through one of its field offices, could another field office be a potential subrecipient?

A field office may apply if and only if the other (subrecipient) office is registered as a separate entity in-country, with a separate DUNS number and SAM.gov. If both the prime and planned sub recipient are sub-entities of a larger organization, without separate in-country registrations. It would be improper for the prime (field office) to subcontract to another field office, as it would be perceived as sub-contracting to itself. Two field offices of the same entity applying for prime and sub-recipient awards would not be considered an allowable "consortium" under this NOFO.

Question # 1a.) For example, if Field Office A.) were to apply as the prime grantee, could Field Office B.) apply for a small grant under this award to then work with their own NGO partners?

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
