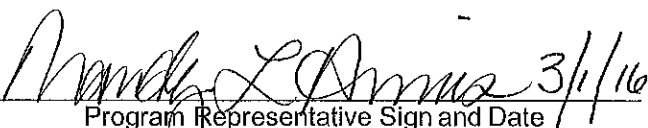

Michigan Department of Natural Resources (MDNR) pilots have conducted statewide productivity flights throughout the life of the project and the institutional knowledge they have is integral to the project. The success of the project is dependent upon surveying all eagle nests within the state of Michigan and the ability to evaluate the nest for nestlings. This requires years of experience and training and could not be confidently performed by pilots other than those of MDNR. Without their experience and knowledge of the location so current nest and their ability to sight new ones the project would suffer greatly.
