- Grant vs. Contract Could you kindly clarify why this opportunity is structured as a grant/cooperative agreement rather than a contract? We'd also appreciate understanding the key differences between the two in this context.
  Government response: The funding opportunity is structured as a cooperative agreement under the authority of 16 U.S.C 670 (Sikes Act).
- 5. Funding Breakdown The announcement mentions a project ceiling of \$1.45 million and a total estimated funding of \$7.58 million. Is the \$7.58 million intended to cover the full five-year period (1 base year plus 4 option years), or just the base year?

**Government response:** The Statement of Work (SOW) in Section I Funding Opportunity Description states the Project Ceiling is Project Ceiling \$1,454,183.14 for the 12-month period of performance. The estimated total funding stated in the Funding Opportunity Announcement is intended to include the base and optional periods of performance.
