Section B. Limitation on Number of Applications Eligible for Review, page 10, states that "An entity	Yes, the prime applicant may submit one application for each topic area (A maximum of two applications). The prime applicant must ensure each application meets the full scope of work for each topic area

		may submit only one application for each topic area contained within this NOFO." While Page 22 states "Applicants may pick which Topic Area for which they wish to submit an application. Applications will be only accepted from each lead applicant for only one of the Topic Areas." Please clarify if a lead applicant can submit a proposal to both Topic Area 1 (Demonstration Projects) and Topic Area 2 (Research and Development Projects) for a combined maximum of two applications. We note that the HALEU Transportation Package FOA (DE-FOA-0002967) Questions and Answers does permit applications for both Topic Areas.	within the Innovative Technology NOFO.

Would such a project be responsive? Or perhaps there is some more appropriate alternative to applying to DE-FOA-0003487, e.g. working with an established DOE contractor? Although not required, an applicant may include one or more federally funded research and development center (FFRDC) as part of its application. Applicants are not required to include an FFRDC in their application.

Gov form. It is unclear whether DOE is requesting one or two Project Management Plans. Please clarify this matter.	Each application should contain a single Project Management Plan (PMP).
