1	9/16/2026	<u>Question #2</u> What committee-member travel volume should applicants assume for each region's annual meetings, training, and site visits?	U.S. Department of Energy's National Transportation Stakeholders Forum (NTSF) Annual Meeting bring about 10-15 members from each State Regional Group (SRG) committee – SRG committee Annual meetings are usually held in conjunction with the NTSF annual meeting, SRGs also typically host mid-year fall meetings with their full committees in their regions, 2 SRG committee members from each region with one SRG support staff member typically attend DOE's semi-annual Transportation Core Group meetings, and about 1 SRG committee member typically attends each of the other SRG and Tribal Radioactive Material Transportation Committee mid-year meetings, and 1 or 2 individual requests for other conferences or trainings throughout the year.
