Questions and Answers on DFOP0018363

- Does INL have a breakdown or estimate of the number or percentage of events and travel that will take place within Bolivia versus internationally (in the U.S. or in third countries)? **Approximately two-thirds of the events and travel will take place within Bolivia.**
- Does INL anticipate requiring in-country support for the delivery of cash payments to beneficiaries and/or to providers within Bolivia? **The grantee should be prepared to offer in-country support for delivery of cash payments.**
- Is legal registration or physical presence in Bolivia required for the implementation of this grant? **INL expects the grantee to follow all domestic law and regulations in Bolivia. INL anticipates a small physical presence will facilitate the activities outlined in this funding opportunity.**
- If the implementer is required to establish an office in Bolivia, does INL have a preferred location for that office? **INL offices are located in the U.S. Embassy in La Paz, Bolivia. While not required, INL anticipates the grantee's physical presence in La Paz will best facilitate the activities outlined in this funding opportunity.**
- Page 5 – Activity 1: “If statutorily or policy required, participants of the travel service grant must be Leahy vetted prior to any funds being expended (See Activity 11).” Can INL confirm whether this reference should instead point to Activity 14 – Background Checks of Travelers, rather than Activity 11 – Monthly Reimbursements? **Correct, the Leahy vetting mentioned in Activity 1 does correspond to Activity 14 rather than Activity 11.**
- Page 8 – Activity 11: “The award recipient must maintain adequate cash flow to cover monthly expenses ranging from \$300,000 USD to \$1,000,000 USD during the reimbursement period.” Over a 24-to-36 months implementation period, the grant would average approximately \$70,000 to \$105,000 in monthly reimbursements, depending on the proposed implementation period. Does INL anticipate an increase in program funding that would result in monthly expenses reaching the stated range of \$300,000 USD to \$1,000,000 USD? **INL does not expect monthly expenses to reach \$1,000,000 USD in the near-term nor would this threshold be expected consistently.**
