

Questions and Answers for APS-OAA-15-000004 (Integrating Community Health)
October 14, 2015

- 1. The solicitation states that there is a limit of one concept paper per applicant. Does applicant refer to the individual project leader/PI or to the organization submitting the proposal? Can two individuals from the same university submit separate concept papers for this APS, or is the limit on the university as a whole?**
 - o The limit is by organization (in this case, the university), not by individual.

- 2. Considering USAID’s Disability Policy, and the fact that persons with disabilities are particularly discriminated against and have very difficult access to health services, particularly in very remote areas, would USAID welcome favorably the inclusion of disability and neglected diseases (e.g. Obstetrical fistula, filariasis) within project proposals submitted in response to this APS?**
 - o Annex 1 in APS-OAA-15-000004 provides details on high impact health and nutrition technical interventions that may be included. At this time, Applicants may not propose activities focusing on disabilities and neglected diseases.

- 3. Can multi-country concepts include a one-page graphical depiction of the health system for each country that will not be counted against the overall 6-page concept paper page limit?**
 - o For multi-country concepts only, applicants may include graphical depictions of the health system for each country - these additional depictions (beyond 1 page), will not be counted against the 6 page limit.
