You have inquired regarding authorization to impact nontidal, unnamed tributaries to the Potomac River to expand Arlington National Cemetery and restore 1,794 linear feet of stream channels within the ANC Millennium Project limits adjacent to Ord & Weitzel Drive in Arlington County.

Based upon review of your request and associated documents, your proposed project does not fall within the jurisdiction of the Marine Resources Commission, therefore, no authorization will be required from this agency.
