Safekeeping/Transportation of Canine Explosives Training Aids

At a minimum the following security procedures for all explosives training aids must be implemented/documented:

- Store all explosives training aids under lock and key.
- Maintain a key and lock control system.
- Appoint a custodian of the system (in writing).
- Institute a key and lock register.
- Maintain a list of personnel authorized to use/issue keys.
- Secure keys in a locked container when not in use.
- Utilize high security padlocks supplied by the NEDCTP.
- Inventory keys and locks once every 90 days.
- Visually check storage site access doors daily (manning permitted).
- Physically check storage site access doors at least weekly.
- Ensure transportation of explosives training aids conforms to all state and local requirements.
