QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1) Question: After my university submitted its application for an NRC research grant, the PI/Co-PI at the prime university and/or subawardee transferred to another university that was not included on the grant application. If the NRC awards the grant to my university, will the NRC then agree to modify the award so that the PI's new university can be considered a recipient or subrecipient/sub-awardee?

Answer: No. The NRC does not permit a change of the recipient/grantee. Also, after the applicant submits the grant application, no new subrecipients/sub-awardees are allowed. The university awardee must take one of the following actions:

- (1) Determine that it can continue to conduct the grant research and propose a new PI/Co-PI who still works at the university, or
- (2) Determine that it cannot continue to conduct the research without the departing PI/Co-PI and ask the NRC to terminate the grant.
