AGENCY: Employment and Training Administration (ETA), Labor

ACTION: Notice: Amendment to SGA/DFA PY 12-03

SUMMARY: The Employment and Training Administration announced on February 28, 2013 the availability of funds and Solicitation for Grant Applications (SGA) for Serving Juvenile Offenders in High-Poverty, High-Crime Communities grants to be awarded through a competitive process. This amendment to the SGA amends language in Section I.B and IV.B.4. The document is hereby amended as follows:

Section I.B. Allowable Uses of Grant Funds (new language in bold)

- **Old Text** – Allowable uses of grant funds for projects funded under these grants may be directly provided by the grantee or contracted.
- **New Text** – Allowable uses of grant funds for projects funded under these grants may be directly provided by the **sub-grantee (or entities contracted by the sub-grantee)**.

Section IV.B. 4 Attachments to the Project Narrative (new language in bold)

- **Old Text** - Chart documenting past performance:
All applicants may reference only one project that was awarded within the last four years, as described above. In the attachment, applicants must also provide the project grant number along with the name, title, name of funding organization, email address and telephone number of an individual from the previous grantor entity or agency who has oversight for the program referenced above and can verify the information stated by the applicant.
- **New Text** - Chart documenting past performance:
All applicants may reference only one project that was **completed on or after January 1, 2009**, as described above. In the attachment, applicants must also provide the project grant number along with the name, title, name of funding organization, email address and telephone number of an individual from the previous grantor entity or agency who has oversight for the program referenced above and can verify the information stated by the applicant.
